

Main ≠: time devoted to research *vs* teaching and other duties





25% of 2020 ULisboa publications and one of the two highest publication rates per capita







Innovate, Monitor, Protect, Defend Portugal against new emerging biological threats of natural, synthetic, intentional or unintentional origin.







- **To pursue funding opportunities** and apply for projects/contracts (as PI or partner) for supporting the research activities



- To mentor students research assignments (advanced training)
- To work ethically and collaboratively
- To participate in the ClÊNCIAS Research Day, held annually (2023 - October 23)





- To create a ClÊNCIAS e-mail account to be used in all work-related communications
